

## Mr. Joseph P. Lopuszynski

August 27, 1929 - March 10, 2017

Joseph Peter Lopuszynski, 87, of Hernando, Fla., passed away on Friday, March 10, 2017.

Joe was born on Aug. 27, 1929, in his family home on Ann Street in Rome, N.Y., to Michael and Marcella (Kedzierski) Lopuszynski, Polish immigrants who came to the United States through Ellis Island in the early 1900s. Joe and his wife, Anne, moved to Hernando 20 years ago from Rye, N.Y., where he and his family lived for 32 years. He retired from IBM as a finance manager after 32 years and was a U.S. Navy veteran.

Joe was Catholic by faith and attended the Transfiguration Elementary School in Rome before graduating from high school as a member of the Rome Free Academy's Class of 1947. He earned his bachelor's degree in economics from the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School. He enjoyed golf, Duke basketball and cooking, with a particular fondness for preparing food from his Polish heritage. He was an avid basketball player in his youth and a member of the Kozick Oilers basketball team.

In addition to his parents, Joe was preceded in death by nine siblings: John, Katherine, Kathryn, Paul, Ann, Nicholas, Frank, Marion, and Walter. He leaves his wife of 55 years, Ada Anne (Livesey) Lopuszynski; two daughters: Marcella, of Hernando, Fla.; and Mary, of Basking Ridge, N.J.; two sons: Michael (Samantha), of Summit, N.J.; and David (Kim), of Holly Springs, N.C.; a brother: Tom (Eileen), of Ashtabula, Ohio; and was proud Dziadek to three grandchildren: Michael, Alexis, and Jack; and uncle to 29 nieces and nephews.

Joe was one of my mother Ann's brothers. He, and sometimes his family, were frequent visitors to the Messenger family, and extended families, the Taylors, Quattlebaums, and Allens. He was the catalyst and sponsor for Polish relatives working and visiting the United States, followed by members of our families visiting Poland. He meticulously researched our families and produced the classic history of the Lopusznskis, full of wonderful stories, legends, and photographs, and he copied and distributed his work. He worked for IBM for 32 years, and was proud that he never owned a personal computer. He eschewed the electronic box, preferring personal contact. He was largely responsible for IBM's flagship presence in the internationally - recognized industrial park known as "RTP" (Research Triangle Park ). A Duke basketball fan, he infamously signed correspondence "Coach K," something Krzyzewski doesn't know about. I think he tried to cover his generous nature with an acerbic wit. My mom's rejoinder was reminding him that she changed his diapers. His reply was - so that's how he got all those pin pricks! An on-the-spot doctor with a defibrillator saved his life at the airport door many years ago. I don't understand why God would call him home now, but He has his hands full. Joe was loved, and is missed.
